<b>3.0</b>	<b>POLICE REPORT</b> – There had been three instances of vandalism in the area since the last meeting – two broken shop front windows at Moss Flowers and at Pacitti Jones Estate Agents and the Plexiglass window on the LCC noticeboard had been spray-painted with football-related graffiti. It is believed that all three incidents occurred on the same weekend. PC McFarland noted that the most important action in such cases is to phone 101 at the earliest opportunity with whatever information is available, however meagre that information seems to be. That gives the best opportunity for Police to investigate and coordinate information, including potential CCTV records.

<b>6.1</b>	A draft submission to the EDC Action Plan was circulated to members by Murdoch Wilson in November, together with an invitation to contribute to the LCC submission or submit directly via the EDC portal. The proposed submission included discussion of several issues and questions relevant to Lenzie. The intention was to receive proposed modifications at the December meeting of LCC and thereafter submit a finalised version to EDC. In the event, one proposal was received and
